RESIDENTIAL PILOT PROGRAM TIME-OF-USE (TOU) RATE SCHEDULE

(Name of Schedule)

AVAILABLE: Limited availability in three communities in the retail distribution service territory of the District.

APPLICABLE: To single-family residences and individually metered apartments for all domestic purposes when all service is supplied through a single meter.

This rate schedule is applicable to residential service Customers in the communities of Chadron, Milford, and Plattsmouth who qualify for and agree to participate in the District's EnergyWiseSM retail pricing pilot program.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE: AC, 60 hertz, single-phase or three-phase, at any of the District's standard secondary voltages.

BASE RATE:

Subject to application of Retail Production Cost Adjustment (PCA) Rate Schedule.

Residential Time-Of-Use Service:

Customer Charge: \$14.25 per month

Energy Charge (per Kilowatt-Hour (kWh)):

Summer

18.20¢	On-Peak Period
6.18¢	Off-Peak Period

Winter

14.03¢	On-Peak Period
4.94¢	Off-Peak Period for the first 500 kWh used per month
3.08¢	Off-Peak Period for all additional kWh used

RESIDENTIAL PILOT PROGRAM TIME-OF-USE (TOU) RATE SCHEDULE

(Name of Schedule)

Energy Time Periods:

Summer

1. The summer rate shall apply to the Customer's prorated use from June 1 through September 30.
2. On-Peak Period will be from 2:00 p.m. through 7:00 p.m. of each day Monday through Friday inclusive.
3. Off-Peak Period will be all other hours each weekday and all day Saturday, Sunday, Independence Day, and Labor Day.

Winter

1. The winter rate shall apply to the Customer's prorated use from October 1 through May 31.
2. On-Peak Period will be from 8:00 a.m. through 9:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. through 8:00 p.m. of each day Monday through Friday inclusive.
3. Off-Peak Period will be all other hours each weekday and all day Saturday, Sunday, New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

All times listed previously are based on either Central Standard Time or Central Daylight Savings Time, whichever is applicable.

BASE RATE ADJUSTMENT:

Customers who are served from distribution facilities for which the District has a Lease Payment (LP) or Debt Service (DS) obligation and/or a 5% Gross Revenue Tax (GRT) obligation will have the Base Rate (excluding PCA) adjusted to include such obligations as shown in the following table :

<u>Applicable Adjustment</u>	<u>Rate Formula</u>
None	Base Rates
Gross Revenue Tax (GRT) Only	Base Rates ÷ 0.95
Lease Payment (LP) or Debt Service (DS) Only	Base Rates ÷ 0.88
LP/DS and GRT	Base Rates ÷ 0.83

In addition, for Customers served from distribution facilities for which the District has a 5% GRT obligation, the PCA will be adjusted to include such obligation by the following formula:
 PCA ÷ 0.95.

MINIMUM BILL: Customer Charge, subject to applicable Base Rate Adjustment.


TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Service will be furnished under the District's Retail Service Rules and Regulations.
2. Extensions made for service under this rate schedule are subject to the provisions of the District's "General Extension Policy for Retail Electric Services and Facilities".
3. The District's General Customer Service Charges Rate Schedule shall apply.
4. Usage shall be fractionalized on the actual days of service for application of a change in rate or changing from summer to winter or from winter to summer rates.
5. At the option of the District, an energy load management switch may be installed that enables the District to turn off the electric water heater for periods of four (4) hours per day when there is an economic need to manage usage.
6. For billing purposes, energy usage shall be normalized to 30 days when actual days of service is less than 27 days or exceeds 35 days in any given billing period.
7. The term of the pilot program will be November 1, 2009 through the October 2010 meter read date of the Customer.

TAX CLAUSE: In the event of the imposition of any new or increased tax or any payment in lieu thereof, in excess of that provided for under Article VIII, Section 11 of the Nebraska Constitution, by any lawful authority on the production, transmission, or sale of electricity, the rate provided herein may be increased to reflect the amount of such tax or in lieu of tax increase.

8. At any time during the pilot, the Customer shall be permitted to drop out of the pilot program and revert to taking service under the Residential Service (RS) Rate Schedule.
9. At the end of the pilot, the District will recalculate the Customer's billings based on the RS Rate Schedule for the period of time the Customer was in the pilot program. The Customer will then receive credit on their account for any amount the billings on this RS-TOU Rate Schedule exceeded the billings calculated under the RS Rate Schedule. This same procedure will be followed for Customers that elect to drop out of the pilot program, with the credit, if applicable, applied to their account at the time they drop out of the pilot program.
10. The District shall provide Customers participating in the pilot program with a power cost monitor that the Customer may keep as long as they remain in the pilot program through their October 2010 meter read date. The District shall also provide a one-time \$50.00 bill credit to Customers participating in the pilot program through their October 2010 meter read date, who complete and return all mid-pilot and post-pilot surveys to the District.
11. The District retains and reserves the right, power, and authority to modify, revise, amend, replace, repeal or cancel this rate schedule, at any time and in whole or in part, by resolution adopted by the District's Board of Directors.
