

Nebraska Public Power District will be holding a third open house regarding a new 115,000-volt electric transmission line needed to serve the electrical requirements of the TransCanada Keystone XL Pipeline being planned in Southern Power District's service area.

The line will connect a new NPPD substation near Clarks to a new substation, owned by Southern Power District, to be located north of Central City. It is also expected to cross through the service territory of Polk County Rural Public Power District.

This round of open houses will deal primarily with proposed "PREFERRED AND ALTERNATIVE LINE ROUTES" within the identified project corridor.
