Industrial Process Incentive Program Guidelines

1. Available to industrial and large commercial customers of Nebraska Public Power District and its wholesale utilities' customers
2. Incentives are not available for Energy Conservation Measures (ECMs) that qualify for other incentive programs.
3. Customer must provide a complete description of existing process and the proposed changes along with an explanation of how energy savings will be achieved. In addition, customer must provide an initial detailed calculation of estimated energy savings. This calculation may be performed by either a consulting engineer, a competent vendor, or the customer's internal support staff.
4. Preapproval application must be completed and preapproved to receive an incentive.
5. To obtain incentive, an Incentive Payment Application must be completed and proof of purchase that itemizes the new equipment indicating the type, make, model, size, and purchase date must be provided. In no case will the incentive be more than 50% of the invoiced project cost.
6. All incentives require approval by the electric utility before purchase or installation.
7. Program is subject to the Terms and Conditions as outlined on the application and the EnergyWiseSM General Guidelines for all Programs.
8. Changes must be implemented and submitted for payment within one year of the preapproval.
