

Nebraska Public Power District will hold a third round of open houses regarding a new 115,000-volt electric transmission line needed to serve the electrical requirements of the TransCanada Keystone XL Pipeline being planned in Loup Valleys Public Power District's service area. The line will connect a new NPPD substation east of Petersburg to a new substation, owned by Loup Valleys Public Power District, to be located east of Ericson. It is also expected to cross through the service territories of Cornhusker Power District and Loup Power District.
