COMMUNITY SOLAR ENERGY RIDER RATE SCHEDULE

(Name of Schedule)

AVAILABLE: Limited availability in communities served by retail distribution service of the District where the District is purchasing the output of a community solar generation project.

APPLICABLE: To any retail Customer of the District (excluding Customers taking service under a lighting rate schedule, the Simultaneous Buy/Sell Service Rider Rate Schedule, the Standby Service Rider Rate Schedule, or the Net Metering Service Rider Rate Schedule) that has entered into a community solar service agreement with the District for purchasing solar energy shares from a community solar generation project located in the Customer's community.

PARTICIPATION LEVEL: The District will sell solar energy shares equal to 150 kWh/month of solar energy. A Customer may purchase any whole number of solar energy shares totaling up to a maximum of 80% of the Customer's annual energy usage. The District reserves the right to limit the maximum number of solar energy shares purchased by an individual commercial or industrial Customer to less than 80% of such Customer's annual energy usage in order to allow additional Customers to take service under this Rate Schedule. The total solar energy shares made available by the District for purchase from a specific community solar generation project will depend upon the size of the project.

ENROLLMENT FEE: The Customer will be charged a \$50 enrollment fee in order to begin taking service under this Rate Schedule. The District will refund this fee to the Customer if the Customer takes service under this Rate Schedule for three (3) consecutive years.

RETAIL BILLING PROCEDURE:

Monthly Customer, Demand, and Energy Charges:

Charges for the Customer's total electric usage during the billing period shall be billed under the provisions of the Customer's applicable standard rate schedule and applicable riders. Subsequent to this calculation, the Solar Energy Charge and the Base Energy Credit will be added to and subtracted from this amount, respectively.

Solar Energy Charge:

TAX CLAUSE: In the event of the imposition of any new or increased tax or any payment in lieu thereof, in excess of that provided for under Article VIII, Section 11 of the Nebraska Constitution, by any lawful authority on the production, transmission, or sale of electricity, the rate provided herein may be increased to reflect the amount of such tax or in lieu of tax increase.

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The applicable per kilowatt-hour charge listed in the Customer's community solar service agreement applied to the Customer's total solar energy purchased for the billing period.

Base Energy Credit:

A 5.8¢ per kilowatt-hour credit applied to the Customer's total solar energy purchased for the billing period. This credit represents the annual cost of non-solar generation included in the District's standard retail rate schedules.

The Base Rate Adjustment provisions of the Customer's applicable standard rate schedule shall apply to the Solar Energy Charge and the Base Energy Credit. The Primary Service Discount, Substation Ownership Discount, and Miscellaneous Municipal Service Discount shall not apply to the Solar Energy Charge and the Base Energy Credit. Any remaining credit that exists after application of the Base Energy Credit for that billing period will be carried forward to the Customer's subsequent billing period as an offset to future charges.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The Customer shall comply with all applicable terms and conditions of its appropriate standard rate schedule.
2. The Customer shall comply with all provisions, terms, and conditions contained in the written community solar service agreement between the District and the Customer.
3. The Customer may cancel or reduce their purchase of solar energy shares at any time, subject to the provisions of its community solar service agreement.
4. The Customer may continue taking service under this rate schedule if the Customer relocates within its community, or if the Customer relocates to another community where solar energy shares are available in a District community solar generation project. In all other cases, service under this Rate Schedule will terminate when a Customer relocates.

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Effective: January 1, 2017

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5. The District shall not sell or transfer any environmental attributes (e.g., green tags, allowances, and certificates) associated with the purchased solar energy units to anyone other than the Customer taking service under this rate schedule.
6. The District retains and reserves the right, power, and authority to modify, revise, amend, replace, repeal or cancel this rate schedule, at any time and in whole or in part, by resolution adopted by the District's Board of Directors.

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
